J U D G M E N T

This testamentary original suit is laid for obtaining Letters of Administration in respect of a Will executed by Late V. Narayanasamy



accordingly, the O.P. originally laid was converted into a suit since then.

The defendants have filed their written statement and the matter is posted for trial. The propounder of the Will was examined as P.W.1 and the attester was examined as P.W.2. At this stage, the matter is now posted before the Court.

2. Both the defendants have filed separate affidavits in Court on 21.04.2021 consenting to the grant of Letters of Administration to the plaintiff. The same is now recorded. Accordingly, this Court holds that the Will of Late V.Narayanasamy Sastrigal is proved and that the plaintiff is hereby granted Letters of Administration.

3. The plaintiff shall execute a security bond for a sum of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) in favour of the Assistant Registrar (O.S.II), High Court, Madras within a period of three (3) months as required under law. No costs.
