2. This condition has been imposed when Crl.A.No.53 of 2020 had been admitted. It is also informed by Mr.E.Raj Thilak, learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) that the petitioner herein is complying with said conditions.



3. In view of that particular statement, the Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is allowed, by relaxing the bail condition, however, placing an obligation that the petitioner should prosecute the appeal, whenever, the appeal is listed for hearing.
