3. That if necessary the Receiver appointed herein, shall get police assistance and the Station House Officer of the concerned Police Station, within whose jurisdiction the vehicle is found, shall render requisite assistance for this purpose.

4. That the order of appointment shall be served on the respondent by the applicant before the Receiver takes any action on the basis of this order.

ORDER



(This case has been heard through video conference)

This application has been filed to appoint the employee of the applicant viz., Mr.Chetan Vasant Bahule, Territory Collection Manager as the Receiver to seize and take possession of the vehicle which is morefully described in the Schedule to the Judges Summons which is lying in the custody of the respondent or respondent's men, agents, servants from respondent premises or wherever found with Police aid and break open of premises, if necessary.

2. It is the case of the applicant that as per the loan agreement dated 11/11/2019, the respondent has availed a sum of Rs.13,20,000/-. As the respondent committed default, it is the contention of the applicant that unless a receiver is appointed to take charge of the vehicle, there will be irreparable injury and the vehicle will be sold by the other side. Hence, it is prayed for appointment of a receiver.

3. In such view of the matter, if the vehicle is allowed to be sold by the respondent, the very right of the applicant will be defeated.

4. Taking into consideration that the applicant has made out a prima facie case and balance of convenience is in favour of the applicant,
