3. Heard Mr.V.Balamurugan, learned counsel for the petitioner and

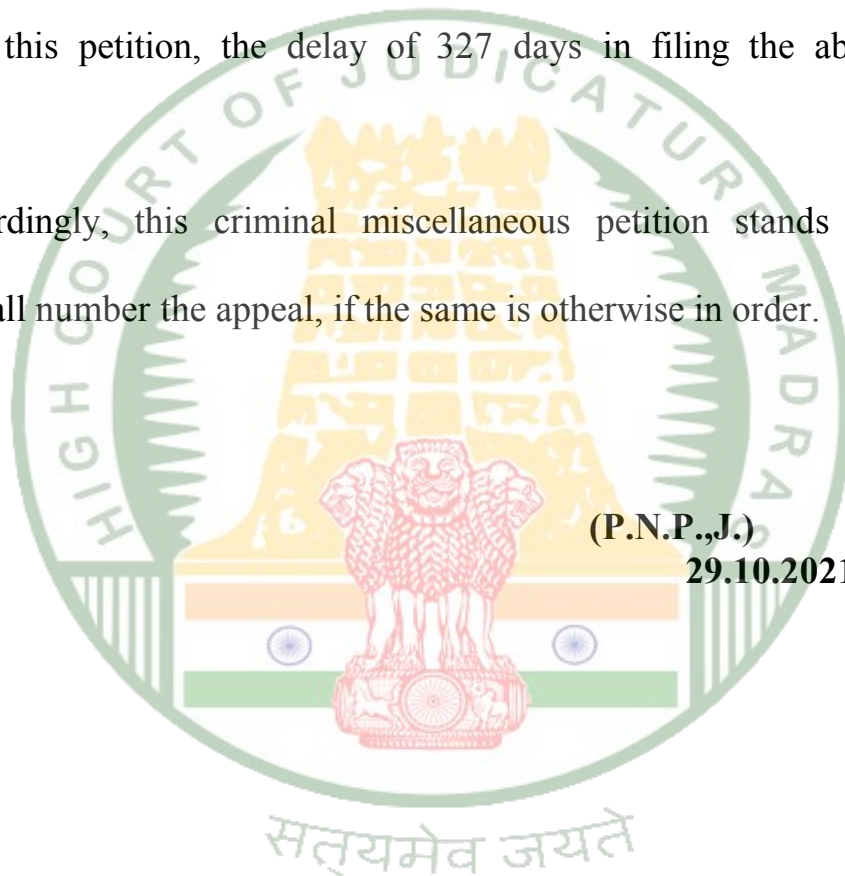
Mr.R.Muniyapparaj, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent/State.
