ORDER

The petitioner who was arrested on 02.08.2021 and remanded to judicial custody for the offences under Section 174 of Cr.P.C and subsequently altered into 306 of IPC in Crime No.1202 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner married the deceased in the year 2010 and out of the wedlock, they have two children. While so on the ear boring function of the children the petitioner demanded dowry from the parents of the deceased and harassed the deceased, due to which the deceased committed suicide by hanging. Hence, the law enforcing agency registered a case against the petitioners.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is no way connected with the alleged offence and he has been falsely implicated in this case and the petitioner has been in jail from 02.08.2021. He further submits that he filed a bail petition in Crl.M.P.No.3572 of 2021 before the Principal District and Sessions Judge, Tiruvallur and the same was dismissed on 16.08.2021. Therefore, he prays to grant bail to the petitioner.



4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent submitted that there is no previous case pending against the petitioner. However, he vehemently opposed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

5. Considering the fact that the petitioner has to take care of the children and also period of incarceration suffered by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions:

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of learned *Judicial Magistrate No.II, Ponneri* and on further condition that:

(a) the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(b) the petitioner shall report before the respondent police, daily at 10.30 a.m. until further orders;

(c) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(d) the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(e) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]*; and;

(f) if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
