Mr.T.G.Ravichandran, learned counsel for the appellant and Mr.R.V.Sivaraj, learned counsel for the second respondent are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties, they arrived at a compromise to settle the matter as follows:

TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

The claimant/ appellant has preferred the present appeal for enhancement of the award from Rs.48,000/-

2. Now parties have agreed to enhance the award amount to Rs,70,000/- in full quit over and above the award amount.

3. The Insurance Company is directed to deposit the enhanced award amount within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.



4. On such deposit, the claimant is entitled to withdraw the amount before the Court below. Award is passed accordingly.

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5. The Tribunal is directed to transfer the amount through RTGS/NEFT to the parties concerned on proper identification in accordance with the terms of the award, without insisting on any formal permission petition. The Civil Miscellaneous Appeal is disposed of accordingly. The connected miscellaneous petition is closed, if any.
