This petition is filed seeking extension of time to comply the condition in the order of this Court dated 15.04.2021 in C.R.P (NPD). No.241 of 2021.

2. This Court, by its order dated 15.04.2021, directed the petitioner to deposit a sum of Rs.30,000/- towards part satisfaction of the suit claim. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner received the order copy only on 13.6.2021. Meanwhile, the petitioner was tested positive for Covid-19 and his wife suffered from chest pain and got admitted in hospital. Therefore, he was unable to comply with the direction of this Court and seeks further time for depositing the sum of Rs.30,000/-.
