2. Heard Mr.P.Ramanathan, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, Mr.T.N.C.Kaushik, learned Government Advocate appearing for the first respondent and Mr.K.Raja Shrinivas, learned Senior Standing Counsel appearing for the respondents 2 and 3.

4. The petitioner has come forward with this Writ Petition for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, forbearing the respondents 2 and 3 from initiating coercive action in pursuance of the lock and seal notice.

6. The grievance of the petitioner is that when the appeal is pending, the respondents are now taking coercive action to implement the notice.

8. The learned Government Counsel appearing for the first respondent would state that the first respondent is ready to pass orders on the appeal of the petitioner in accordance with law.

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of the matter, directs the first respondent to dispose of the appeal preferred by the petitioner under Section 80-A of the Town and Country Planning Act, dated 25.08.2021, on merits and in accordance with law, after affording ample opportunity to the necessary parties, within a period of four months. Till then, the respondents 2 and 3 shall not take any coercive action.

10. With the above directions, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
