PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence under Sections 379, 430 of IPC and section 21(1) of Mines and Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act, 1957 in Crime No.122 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner was transported $\frac{1}{4}$ unit of river sand by using lorry. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case. Hence, he prays to grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4.The learned Government Advocate submitted that the petitioner has illegally transported $\frac{1}{4}$ unit of sand by using lorry and hence he opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5.This court is of the opinion that these types of cases are impacting large Magnitude and the petitioner is misusing the discretionary power of this Court and continues with the offences affecting the environment and ecology.



6. Accordingly, this criminal original petition is dismissed.
