Despite the petitioner has made a specific allegation as against the driver of the lorry, who had driven the lorry in a drunken state, no action has been taken. Hence, the present petition.

3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent would submit that on the complaint of the Vijayakumar, injured, who was riding a bike, a case in Crime



No.147 of 2021 had been registered, on 07.08.2021, for the offences under sections 279, 337 IPC and Section 192(A) of Motor Vehicles Act. He would further submit that after completion of investigation, on 18.09.2021, charge sheet filed before the IV Metropolitan Magistrate, Saidapet and the same is yet to be taken on file.
