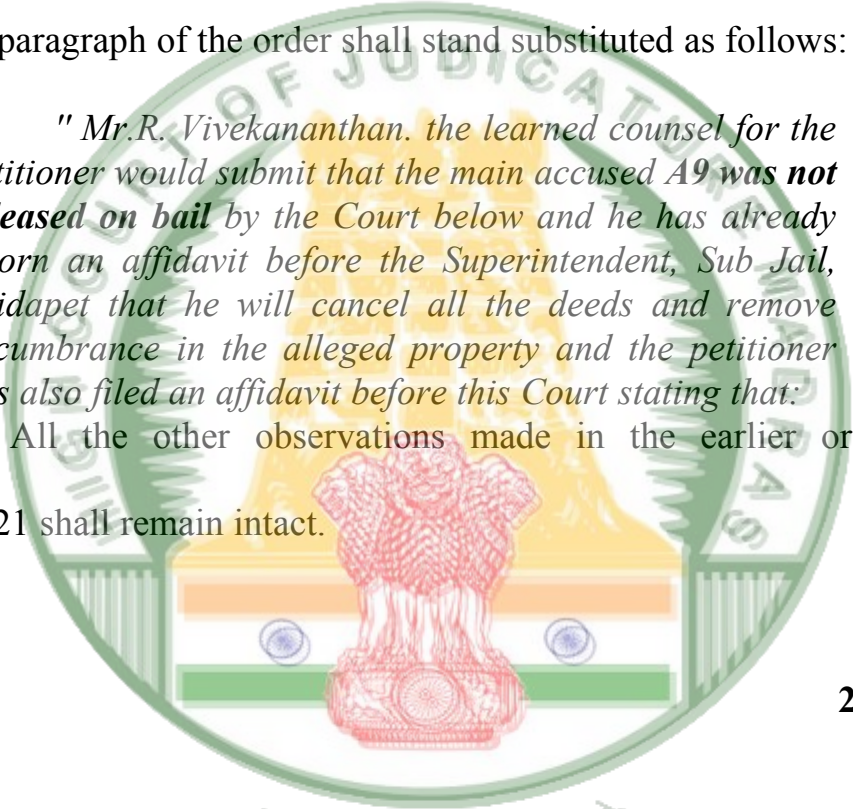
2. In continuation of the earlier order of this Court dated 17.09.2021, the third paragraph of the order shall stand substituted as follows:
