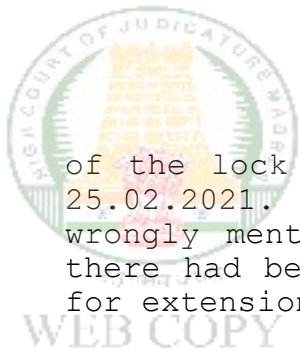

Order : This petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition and the filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/S. I.ABRAR MOHAMED ABDULLAH, Advocate for the Petitioner and of MR.S.SUGENDRAN Govt. Advocate (Crl. Side) on behalf of the Respondent the court made the following order:-

This Criminal Miscellaneous Petition has been filed by the Petitioner seeking for extension of time to comply with the conditions imposed by this Court in Crl.M.P.No.7176 of 2020 in Crl.R.C.No.1033 of 2020 by order dated 23.11.2020.

2.Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner was granted suspension of sentence in Crl.M.P.No.7176 of 2020 in Crl.R.C.No.1033 of 2020 by order dated 23.11.2020 and the petitioner was directed to surrender before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.1, Pollachi within 15 days from the date of receipt of copy of that order and that the petitioner was directed to report before the said court once in three months until further orders. He would further submit that copy application was filed on 20.04.2021 and the court made ready only on 09.06.2021 and further in view



of the lock down, they were able to receive the order copy only on 25.02.2021. Further in the said order, the crime number was wrongly mentioned as 31 of 2010 instead of 31 of 2020 and thereby there had been some confusion in surrendering and thereby would seek for extension of time.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the materials on record.

4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, time granted by this Court in Crl.M.P.No.7176 of 2020 in Crl.R.C.No.1033 of 2020 by order dated 23.11.2020 is extended by further period of two weeks from today.
