Petition filed under Order IV Rule 1 of original side rules read with order VII Rule 1 of C.P.C praying to

a) Grant a relief of Declaration that the emails dated 07.09.2021 issued by the 1st defendant through the 2nd defendant and any acts done pursuant to the said emails dated 07.09.2021 is illegal and non-est.

b) Grant a relief of permanent injunction restraining Defendants 1 & 2 or the representatives from in any manner taking steps pursuant to the emails dated 07.09.2021 and any subsequent letters.

c) Grant a relief of permanent injunction restraining Defendants 1 to 4, its men, agents or representatives, from making or attempting to malign the plaintiff's reputation which is in any manner derogatory or defames the plaintiff's reputation.

d) Direct the defendants 1 to 4 to pay jointly and severally as sum of Rs.1,00,00,000/- as damages to the plaintiff.

e) pay the cost of the suit.

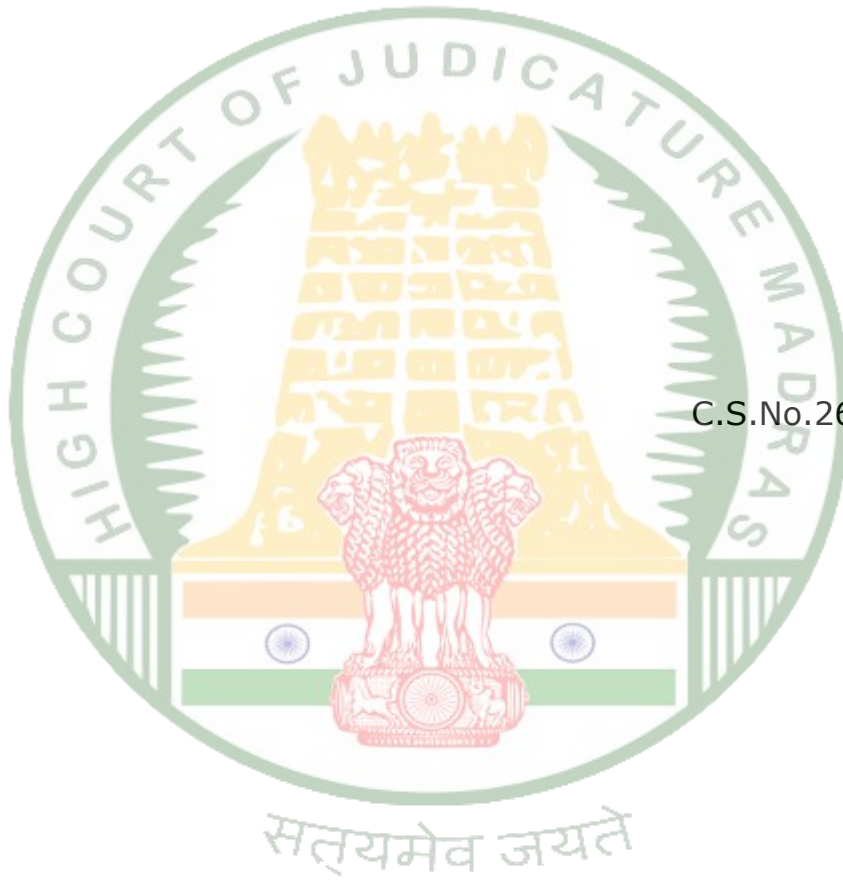


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
