PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence under Sections 294(b), 324, & 506(ii) of I.P.C. in Cr.No.841 of 2021, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that there was a dispute between the petitioner and the De-facto Complainant for managing self help group, where a wordy quarrel arose between the petitioner and the De-facto Complainants. During which, the petitioner attacked the Defacto Complaint with a glass bottle and abused him with filthy language. Hence the complaint.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case. Hence he prays for grant of anticipatory bail.



4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the investigation is pending in this case and there is one previous case against the petitioner hence he strongly opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. Considering the fact that there is one previous case against the petitioner, this court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the petition seeking anticipatory bail is dismissed.
