Prayer:-

Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus, to direct the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for promotion as Chief Stores Officer on par with his batch mates/juniors without reference to service qualification but by taking into account of the earlier promotion for all purposes and to consequently extend all benefits, including seniority, promotion and other service benefits therein forthwith.
