The Controversy between the petitioner and the 6th respondent is relating to tenancy.

2.The grievances of the writ petitioner is that the 6th respondent, who is a tenant, is to be evicted.

3.However, it is a private dispute between the writ petitioner and the 6th respondent and the petitioner claims that the subject property belongs to him. All such disputes cannot be resolved in a writ proceedings and such Civil rights are to be established before the competent Court of Law with reference to the documents and evidences made available.

4. Thus, the petitioner is at liberty to approach the competent Court of law for the purpose of redressal of his grievances in the manner known to law.

5. With this liberty, the writ petition stands disposed of. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
