



4. The learned Public Prosecutor (Puducherry) submitted that the petitioner had entered into the house of the defacto complainant and sexually assaulted her minor daughter and threatened her with dire consequences. He further submits that there is serious allegation made against the petitioner. Hence, he vehemently opposed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

5. This Court is of the view that on perusal of the FIR, there is serious allegation made against the petitioner and considering the gravity of offence, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
