ORDER

The petitioner has challenged this writ petition by directing the the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent to conduct an enquiry based on the letter sent by the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent in O.Mu.No.4533/2020/U3 dated 28.02.2020, as well as to direct the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent to conduct an enquiry based on the letter sent by the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent in O.Mu.2534/2021/Ka3 dated 11.02.2021.

2.The petitioner has sent a representation to the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> respondents who have in turn and forwarded the same to the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> respondents by their communication dated 28.02.2020 and 11.02.2021. However, these letters of the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> respondents have not evoked any response from the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> respondents.

3.Considering the same, this writ petition is disposed at the time of admission without notice to the respondent by directing the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> respondents to consider the representation of the petitioner in terms of letters of the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> respondents and are take steps in accordance with law. In case, any adverse proceedings is to be initiated against the 6<sup>th</sup> respondent, same may be initiated in terms of the applicable law and on merits. The 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> respondents shall dispose the same and pass appropriate orders within a period of 12 weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. It is made clear that if any adverse action is proposed to be taken against the 6<sup>th</sup> respondent, it shall be after due notice to the 6<sup>th</sup> respondent. No costs.
