COMMON ORDER

Today, when these matters came up for hearing, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners, on instructions, submitted that subsequent to the filing of these writ petitions, notification in question has been challenged by filing a batch of writ petitions and hence, nothing survives for adjudication.
