



4. The learned Government Advocate submitted that the petitioner along with other accused person were found in illegal possession of 60 numbers of Nitrazepam Tablets weighing 42 grams and sold the same to the young students. He further submitted that the investigation is not completed. Hence, he vehemently opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. Considering the facts and circumstance of the case and the fact that the seized contraband are scheduled drug and by selling the same they have spoiled very many youngsters of that area, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
