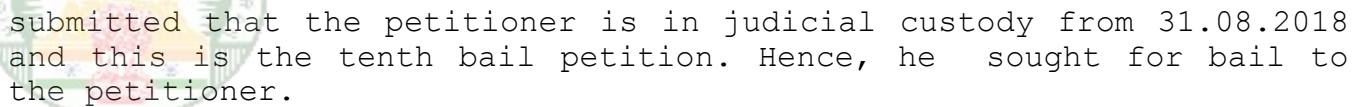

ORDER

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 31.08.2018, for the offence punishable under Sections 302, 120(b) r/w 109 of IPC in Crime No.1101 of 2018 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the defacto complainant is the husband of the first accused and they had two children. It is alleged that the first accused had illegal relationship with this petitioner/ A2 due to which, the first accused is alleged to have committed murder of her own two children with the help of this petitioner / A2. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner did not commit any offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case. Further, he



5. It is seen that this is the tenth bail petition. However, there is no change of circumstances in this case. Therefore, this court is not inclined to entertain this petition. This Court already directed the trial court to complete the trial within the stipulated time. Due to corona pandemic circumstances, the trial court could not complete the trial within the period stipulated by this Court. However, now the circumstances are changed and physical hearing started in the trial court. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the trial court is directed to complete the trial within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
