



4.The learned Government Advocate would submit that this is the second anticipatory bail application filed by the petitioner and this Court has already dismissed the earlier anticipatory bail application of the petitioner in Crl.O.P.No.14789 of 2021 dated 06.09.2021. The petitioner in order to stop the marriage of the de-facto complainant with another person, contacted the bridegroom and sent the photos which he had taken with the de-facto complainant, due to which, the marriage was cancelled and the de-facto complainant and her family members were subjected to mental stress. Hence, he vehemently opposed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5.Considering the gravity of offence and the earlier anticipatory bail petition was dismissed by this Court and there is no change of circumstances, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6.Accordingly, this criminal original petition is dismissed.
