PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

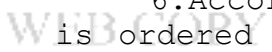
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence under Sections 457 & 511 of I.P.C in Cr.No.271 of 2021, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that while the De-facto Complainant was on duty, three persons entered the premises where he was working. On seeing them the De-facto Complainant called the security whereby they were apprehended at that time they informed that they have come to steal the battery at the instigation of other accused persons. Hence the Complaint.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case. Hence he prays for grant of anticipatory bail.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submitted that while stealing the battery the petitioner was apprehended.
