2.Heard the learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner.

3.The learned Government Advocate submitted that the petitioner is complying with the condition regularly.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court modify the condition already imposed on the petitioner to the effect that the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police, once in a week i.e., on every Monday at 10.30 a.m. till the investigation is completed and charge sheet is filed.
