The petitioner challenges the impugned order of detention in C.M.P.No.19/B.L.A./C2/2020 on 30.11.2020, detaining her husband as "Bootlegger" under Section 2(b) of the Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982.

Side) appearing for the respondents reports that the order of detention passed against the detenu has been revoked by the Government by its order in G.O.Rt.No.362, Home, Prohibition and Excise (XIV) Department, dated 18.01.2021 and he has also produced a copy of the Government Order.
