PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest for the alleged offence under Section 379, 430 of IPC. and 21(1) of Mines and Minerals Act 1957 in Crime No.628 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner along with other accused persons were involved in illegal transportation of two units of river sand by using mini tipper SURAJ MAZDA.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case. Hence, he prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submitted that the petitioner along with other accused person have illegally transported two

units of river sand by using mini tipper SURAJ MAZDA and there is no previous case pending against the petitioner. However, he opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. This court is of the opinion that these type of cases are impacting large Magnitude and the petitioner is misusing the discretionary of this Court and continues with the offences affecting the environment and ecology.

6. Accordingly, this criminal original petition is dismissed.
