3. In view of the above submission, this Court is of the considered view that the prayer as sought for by the petitioners could be acceded to.

Accordingly, the condition insofar as appearance as imposed by order dated 17.09.2021 alone stands relaxed and the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation and before the trial court on each and every hearing date. All other conditions remain unaltered.
