This petition is filed to condone the delay of 118 days in filing the above appeal.

2.Mr.C.Paranthaman, the learned counsel, who takes notice for the 2nd respondent/Insurance Company, submitted that the 2nd respondent has no objection in ordering this petition and prayed to waive the interest for the delay period.
