This case was listed under the caption 'for being mentioned' today at the instance of the learned counsel for the petitioner.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this Writ Petition was disposed on 02.11.2021. However, certified



copy of the order and web copy of the order shows that this Writ Petition has been dismissed as withdrawn.
