



4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl side) submits that this is the second anticipatory bail application of the petitioner. On 26.05.2021, the accused persons presented a forged cheque for a sum of Rs.6 Crores for encashment, On suspicion, the defacto complainant, who is a Branch Manager of the HDFC Bank, verified the cheque and found that the same is forged one. Hence, he opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and some of the accused persons have not been secured so far and there is no change of circumstances, hence, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original petition is dismissed.
