Prayer in W.P.No.24713 of 2021: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondent to provisionally release the seized imported goods covered under Bill of Entry No.4877256, dated 31.07.2021, seized under Mahazar dated 06.08.2021 under Section 110 A of the Customs Act, as prayed for by the petitioner in their request letter dated 26.08.2021 04.09.2021, 11.09.2021 and 12.10.2021 taking into consideration of the sensitive nature of the goods, the quality of the same may deteriorate due to the present weather conditions.

Prayer in W.P.No.24715 of 2021: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondent to provisionally release the seized imported goods covered under Bill of Entry No.4882115, dated 31.07.2021, seized under Mahazar dated 05.08.2021 under Section 110 A of the Customs Act, as prayed for by the petitioner in their request letter dated 26.08.2021 04.09.2021, 11.09.2021 and 12.10.2021 taking into consideration of the sensitive nature of the goods, the quality of the same may deteriorate due to the present weather conditions.



Prayer in W.P.No.24716 of 2021: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondent to provisionally release the seized imported goods covered under Bill of Entry No.4927400, dated 04.08.2021, seized under Mahazar dated 19.08.2021 under Section 110 A of the Customs Act, as prayed for by the petitioner in their request letter dated 26.08.2021, 04.09.2021, 11.09.2021 and 12.10.2021 taking into consideration of the sensitive nature of the goods, the quality of the same may deteriorate due to the present weather conditions.
