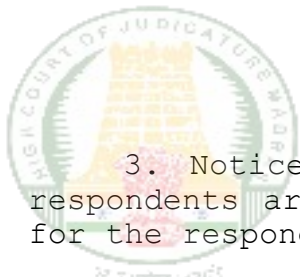

This petition has been filed seeking to condone the delay of 211 days in filing the revision against the order dated 29.05.2019 passed by the IV Additional Family Court, Chennai in M.P.No.86 of 2019 in M.C.No.120 of 2018.

2. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has been suffering from prolonged illness on account of "Varicose Veins" disease and that due to covid he is unemployed and he was unable to file the petition in time.

4. Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to condone the delay. Accordingly, the delay is condoned on condition that the petitioner pays a sum of Rs.1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) to the Advocate Welfare Fund, Bar Council of Tamil Nadu and Puducherry within the period of one week.
