ORDER

(The case has been heard through video conference)

The petitioner who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 21.10.2021 for the offence under Section 304(2) of IPC, in Crime No.236 of 2021, on the file of the respondent police seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the deceased was working as a Security in OLA Company. On the date of occurrence, the petitioner picked up a quarrel with the deceased and started to attack the deceased. On hearing the information, the defacto complainant and the daughter of deceased went to the place to stop the incident. By the time, the petitioner had attacked the deceased hardly. Immediately, they took him to hospital wherein, he was declared as brought dead. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. He would further



submit that the petitioner has been suffering incarceration for more than 25 days from 21.10.2021. Hence, he seeks for grant of bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate raised objection stating that the petitioner is the sole accused and out of wordy quarrel, the occurrence had happened but admits that the investigation is almost completed.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that the investigation is almost completed and also considering the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Uthangarai, and on further conditions that:

(a) the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(b) the petitioner shall report before the respondent police on every Saturday at 10.30 a.m. until further orders.

(c) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness during trial;

(d) the petitioner shall not abscond during trial;

(e) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]; and;

(f) if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
