PRAYER in CRP/1032/2017:

This Civil Revision Petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, against the impugned order dated 02.03.2017 passed by the Principal District Judge, Pondicherry in I.A.No.402 of 2017 in Arb.O.P.No.17 of 2017, in so far as directing the petitioners to deposit Rs.19,30,882/- along with 50% of the additional financial charges amounting to Rs.24,04,267/- towards belated payments totally Rs.43,35,149/- passed by the Principal District Judge, Pondicherry.

PRAYER in CRP/1033/2017:

This Civil Revision Petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, against the impugned order dated 02.03.2017 passed

by the Principal District Judge, Pondicherry in I.A.No.403 of 2017 in Arb.O.P.No.18 of 2017, in so far as directing the petitioners to deposit Rs.13,65,250/- along with 50% of the additional financial charges amounting to Rs.19,41,437/- towards belated payments totally Rs.33,06,687/- passed by the Principal District Judge, Pondicherry.

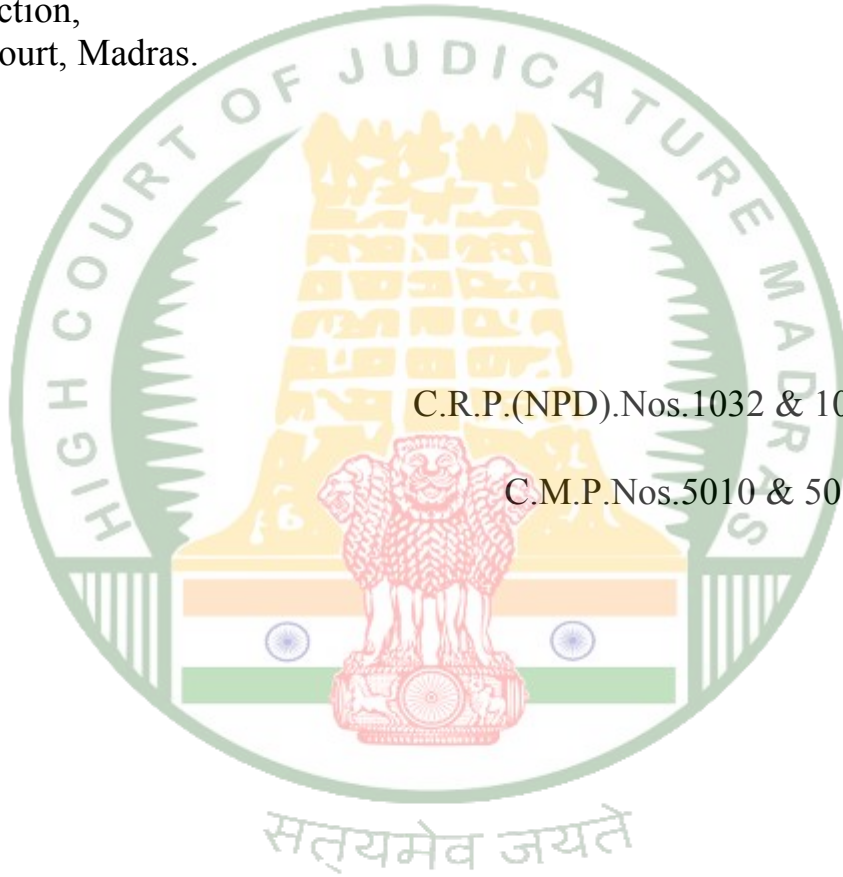
