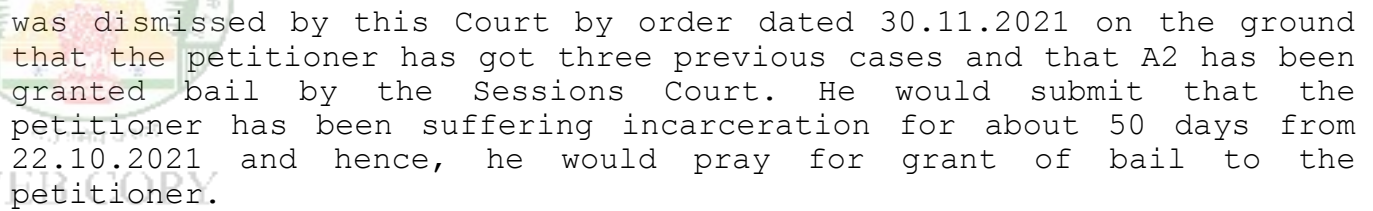
ORDER

(The case has been heard through video conference)

The petitioner who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 22.10.2021 for the offence under Sections 341, 294(b), 363, 307 and 506(ii) of IPC, in Crime No.823 of 2021, on the file of the respondent police seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that on 14.09.2021, the petitioner and other accused persons waylaid the defacto complainant and abused him with filthy language and assaulted him with knife and due to which the defacto complainant sustained grievous injuries in his wrist and forehead. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is no way connected with the alleged offence and he has been falsely implicated in this case. He would further submit that this is the second application for bail and the earlier application



5. Considering the fact that the injured has been discharged from the hospital and the investigation is almost completed and also considering the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

(a) the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(c) the defacto complainant is permitted to withdraw the said deposit amount of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) on proper identification and acknowledgment.

(e) the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(g) if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
