PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence under Section 294(b), 353, 506(2), 307 of IPC and 3 of TNPPDL Act, in Crime No.1381 of 2021, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the first accused had abused the defacto complainant and attacked their bike and broke their bike mirror by knife. Based on the confession of the first accused, the petitioner was implicated in this case.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case. He further submitted that based on the confession of co-accused, the petitioner was falsely implicated in this case. Hence, he prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.



4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that there are 6 previous cases pending against the petitioner and the first accused was detained under Act 14 of 1982. He further submitted that the investigation is at initial stage. Hence, he vehemently opposed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also the fact that there are 6 previous cases pending against the petitioner and the investigation is at initial stage, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
