



implicated in this case and he has been in jail from 12.08.2021. Hence, he prays for grant of bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate would submit that this is the 4th bail application of the petitioner. The petitioner had sexually abused the minor girls, who studying in the said school and 164 statement has also been recorded from the victim girl. He further submitted that if the petitioner is granted bail, he would tamper the witnesses and the trial would go delay. Hence, he vehemently opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. Considering the gravity of offence and earlier petition was dismissed by this Court and there is no change of circumstances, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, this criminal original petition is dismissed.
