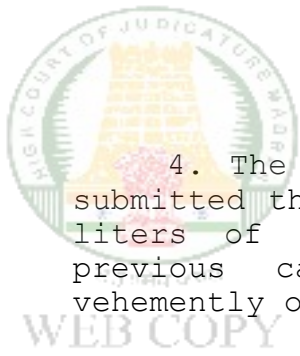

O R D E R

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 4(1) (aaa), 4(1-A) (ii) of Tamil Nadu Prohibition Act r/w 328 of IPC, in Crime No.610 of 2018, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. It is the case of the prosecution that the petitioner was found in illegal possession of 58 liters of I.D Arrack. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submit that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. However, on instructions, the learned counsel further submitted that the petitioner, on his own volition, is ready and willing to contribute a sum of Rs.10,000/- to the credit of the Registered Advocate Clerk Association, Thirupathur, that may be imposed by this Court Hence, he prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.



4. The learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondent submitted that the petitioner was found in illegal possession of 58 liters of I.D Arrack. He further submits that there are seven previous cases pending against this petitioner. However, he vehemently opposed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. Taking into consideration the facts of the case and the submissions made by the learned counsels and also taking note of the fact that the petitioner has come forward to deposit an amount of Rs.10,000/- to the credit of the Registered Advocate Clerk Association, Thirupathur, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner subject to the following conditions:-

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Thirupathur, on condition that the petitioners shall execute separate bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed and on further condition that:

[a] the petitioner is directed to deposit a sum of Rs.10,000/- to the credit of the Registered Advocate Clerk Association, Thirupathur, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and shall produce the said receipt before the Court below.

[b] the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[c] the petitioner is directed to report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders;

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[f] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].



[g] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
