TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

Both the parties are present along with their counsels. A Joint Memorandum of Compromise dated 11.09.2021 has been filed by the parties duly signed by them and their respective counsels.

2. In view of the above compromise, the Criminal Revision Petition Shall stand disposed of on the terms of the Joint Memorandum of Compromise. The joint memo of compromise shall form part of the order. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petitions are closed, if any. The judgment of conviction and sentence passed by the Courts below are set aside and the petitioner is acquitted of the charge under Section 138 of the N.I. Act.
