Today when the case is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the first respondent, on instructions, submitted that charge sheet has been filed and the 2nd respondent was arrested and thereafter, he has been complied with the condition imposed by the trial court in C.C.No.12 of 2019 before the learned Judicial Magistrate-I, Chennai.
