Today, when the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submitted that the present Civil Revision Petition is filed against the fair and decretal order dated 14.03.2017 made in I.A.No.343 of 2016 in O.S.No.22 of 2012 on the file of the Sub Court, Perundurai, filed for appointment of an Advocate Commissioner to note down the physical features of the suit property. 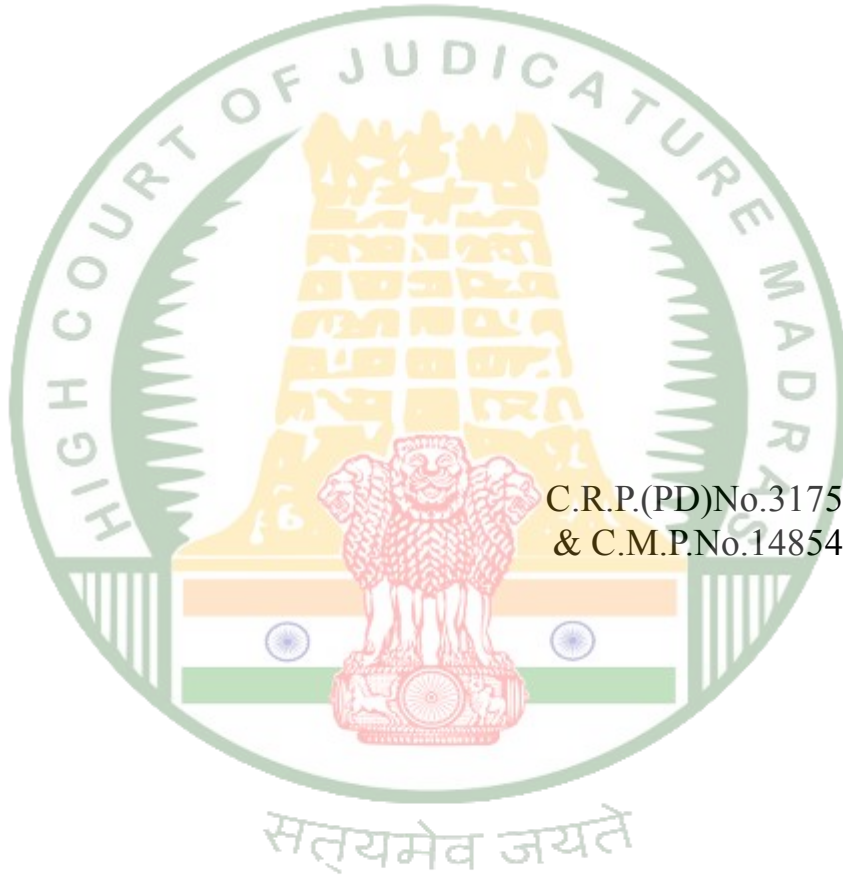
