Upon hearing the submission made by the learned Counsel on both sides and on being satisfied with the reasons stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the petition is allowed on condition that the petitioners/appellants shall pay a sum of Rs.2,000/- (Rupees two thousand only) to the Chief Justice Relief Fund within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order, failing which, the order shall stand vacated automatically without further reference to this Court.

5. The Registry is directed to number the appeal upon production of proof of payment of Rs.2,000/-, if it is otherwise in order and list the same for admission.
