ii) that the Ist Respondent herein/N.Panneerselvam be and hereby is directed to deposit the entire amount awarded by the Tribunal together with interest at 7.5% p.a. from the date of claim petition till the date of realization, less the amount, if any, already deposited to the credit of respective MCOP No.115 of 2006 on the file of Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, (Subordinate Judge), Mettur within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this Judgment;

iii) that on such deposit being made, that the Tribunal be and hereby is directed to transfer the award amount directly to the bank account of the Appellant/Claimant through RTGS, within a period of two weeks thereafter;

iv) that there be no costs in this Appeal.
