The present petition is filed seeking for a direction to the first respondent not to harass the petitioner under the guise of an enquiry.

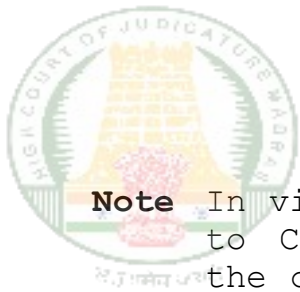
