Side) on behalf of the Respondent, the Court made the following order:-

This petition is filed to extend the time limit of the petitioner's surrender and execute sureties in CrI.O.P(MD)No.6307 of 2020, dated 17.06.2020.

2.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate(CrI.Side) for the respondent.

3.Considering the reasons stated in the petition, this petition is ordered and the time for surrender by the petitioner before the concerned Court and executing the sureties is extended by two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. However, it is made clear no further extension of time will be granted. If the petitioner fails to execute sureties within two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order the respondent police is directed to secure the accused and proceed in accordance with law.



4. Accordingly, this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is allowed.
