Prayer in CRL.M.P. (MD) No.2867 of 2021:-

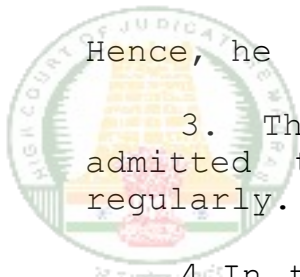

This Criminal Miscellaneous Petition coming on for orders on this day and upon perusing the earlier order dated 03.02.2021 and the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/s.K.Sivabalan, Advocate for the Petitioner and of M/s.Bharathi, Government Advocate (Criminal Side) for the 1st and 2nd Respondents, this Court made the following order:

The petitioner filed this petition for relaxing the bail condition imposed by this Court on the petitioner in Crl.A.(MD) No.30 of 2021 dated 03.02.2021.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is abiding the condition imposed by this Court without any deviation and the investigation was over and charge sheet filed.



Hence, he prayed the condition to be relaxed.
