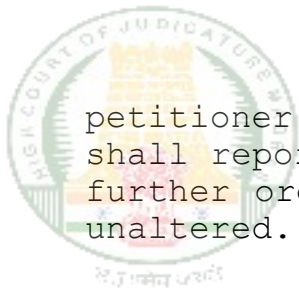

Side) on behalf of the Respondent, the Court made the following order:-

This Court, while granting bail to the petitioner by order dated 08.12.2020, imposed a condition to the effect that the petitioner should report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., 1.30 p.m., and 5.30 p.m., until further orders. Seeking to relax the condition, the present petition has been filed.

2. Heard both sides.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent Police submitted that the petitioner is having five previous cases and he has not appeared before the respondent Police after 10.01.2021.

4.Considering the submission made by the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side), the condition already imposed on the
