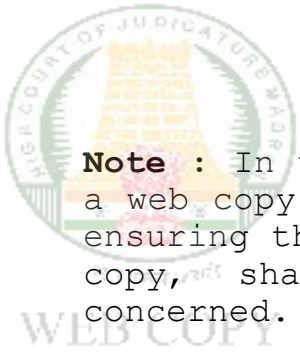
2. In view of the same, this Petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However the respondent police is directed to take suitable action in this regard.
