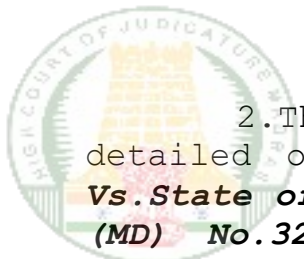

2.This issue has already been settled by this Court by a detailed order, dated 29.01.2019 in the case of **V.Krishnamurthy Vs.State of Tamil Nadu**, passed in a **batch of Writ Petitions in W.P. (MD) No.32710 of 2005 etc.**, In the said order, all the Writ Petitions were dismissed following the dictum laid down by the Honourable Supreme Court in the case of **State of Kerala and others Vs.Fr.William Fernandez** reported in **2017 SCC Online SC 1291**.

3.Accordingly, these Writ Petitions are also dismissed. No costs. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petitions are closed.
