2.In view of the above, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn. No costs.

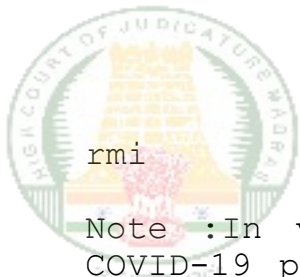
